I would like to use the Artist Fellowship Grant to research, draft, and revise work on (ideally facilitated through attending one or more writing residencies) a sixth collection of poetry, tentatively titled #stringofbeads--a project that I have envisioned as an ecocritical and decolonizing collage of braided tanka, zuihitsu, and "kaze no denwa" poems. As a central and centering element of this book project, there will be a series of #kazenodenwa ("wind phone") poems--elegiac intrusions that pay homage to that which is lost, destroyed, disappearing, extinct, and/or dead--inspired by a phone booth with a disconnected rotary-dial phone in Otsuchi, Japan, where survivors of the 2011 Tohoku earthquake/tsunami and Fukushima disaster have been making pilgrimages to "speak" to their dead.
