ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

Eligibility
All K-12 students in South Dakota may participate in the Governor's Student Art Competition. Work with your art teacher, classroom teacher or homeschool teacher to submit the artwork and appropriate forms on behalf of students.

Details

The competition is juried, and three student artworks in each division are selected for display in the South Dakota State Capitol for up to one year.

Divisions

are determined by grade:
Kindergarten through 2nd grade
3rd through 5th grade
6th through 8th grade
9th through 12th grade

We may ask students to consider selling their artwork to the state at the end of the exhibition. However, if a student does not want to submit their artwork for purchase, the art will be returned to them at the end of the year-long exhibition.

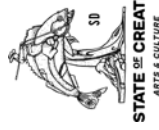
