

Artist Restrictions

Recent Recipient – Artist Grant recipients are generally not eligible to apply for the same grant for three years after the completion of their grant period. For example, an artist with a grant that started on July 1, 2025, CANNOT APPLY for the same grant until the winter of 2028. Many artist grant categories carry specific exclusions, so check the table below for specifics. Not sure when you got your grant?
